- Matthew 5:6—Blessed are those who hunger and thirst for righteousness, for they shall be satisfied.
- Phil 4:19—And my God will supply every need of yours according to His riches in glory in Christ Jesus

Confession-- *Silently confessing your sins to our God who forgives*--discontentment, coveting, ingratitude, envy, a critical spirit, any tendency to be greedy or dissatisfied with what God has provided me, the times I desire success apart from the Lord

Thanksgiving—Thanking God for **what He has done**. *Please no prayer requests during this time.*
