

## WPC Conference 2020 Prayer Sheet - Sunday

**Praise**—Praising God for **who He is**, His attributes, His name or His character.

**Attribute: God is Steadfast**

**Definition:** firmly fixed in place, resolutely or dutifully determined and unwavering.

**Scripture(s):**

- Psalm 26:2-3—Prove me, O Lord, and try me; test my heart and my mind. For Your steadfast love is before my eyes, and I walk in Your faithfulness.
- Lamentations 3:21-25—But this I call to mind and therefore I have hope: The steadfast love of the Lord never ceases, His mercies never come to an end; they are new every morning; great is Your faithfulness. The Lord is my portion, says my soul, therefore I will hope in Him. The Lord is good to those who wait for Him, to the soul who seeks Him.
- 1 Corinthians 15:58—Therefore, my beloved brothers, be steadfast, immovable, always abounding in the work of the Lord, knowing that your labor is not in vain.
- 2 Peter 1:5-8—For this very reason, make every effort to supplement your faith with virtue, and virtue with knowledge, and knowledge with self-control, and self-control with steadfastness, and steadfastness with godliness, and godliness with brotherly affection, and brotherly affection with love. For if these qualities are yours and increasing, they will keep you from being ineffective or unfruitful in the knowledge of our Lord Jesus Christ.
- James 1:2-4, 12—Count it all joy, my brothers, when you meet trials of various kinds, for you know that the testing of your faith produces steadfastness. And let steadfastness have its full effect, that you may be perfect and complete, lacking in nothing...Blessed is the man who remains steadfast under trial, for when he has stood the test he will receive the crown of life, which God has promised to those who love Him.

**Thoughts:** *Steadfastness isn't simply passively surviving difficulties; it's actively overcoming them by responding to them with faith and joy. How? By keeping our eyes on Jesus who endured the cross for us.—Nancy DeMoss Wolgemuth*

**Confession**—*silently confessing your sins to the God who forgives-* the times when I am frustrated and resentful about the difficult circumstances God has allowed into my life, rationalizing or justifying my sinful attitudes and actions during trials, quitting when I know God has called me to persevere

*Have mercy on me, O God, according to Your steadfast love; according to Your abundant mercy blot out my transgressions. Wash me thoroughly from my iniquity, and cleanse me from my sin!—Psalm 51:1-2*

**Thanksgiving**—Thanking God for **what He has done**. *Please no prayer requests during this time.*

*I give thanks to You, O Lord my God, with my whole heart, and I will glorify Your name forever. For great is Your steadfast love toward me; You have delivered my soul from the depths of Sheol.—Psalm 86:12*

**Petition/Intercession**—Coming to God in prayer on behalf of ourselves and others

**Scripture:** *May \_\_\_\_\_ pursue righteousness, godliness, faith, love, steadfastness, and gentleness. May \_\_\_\_\_ fight the good fight of the faith and take hold of the eternal life to which he/she was called.—from 1 Timothy 6:11-12*
